The Village of Johnson Creek and Jefferson County, in accordance with National Flood Insurance Program regulation 65.7(b)(1), hereby gives notice of the Village of Johnson Creek intent to revise the flood hazard information along Johnson Creek, generally located between the confluence with the Rock River and Union Street. The flood hazard revisions are being proposed as part of Conditional Letter of Map Revision (CLOMR) Case No. 24-05-0085R for a proposed project along Johnson Creek.

The Village of Johnson Creek is proposing to extend Gosdeck Lane, from where it currently terminates within the Chapel Hill subdivision, to the south over Johnson Creek to make a new connection with County Highway B/Aztalan Street.

The project intent to provide another traffic route to the elementary and high school campuses located along Aztalan Street. This north-south connection is important to community connectivity as it will improve traffic circulation and reduce the traffic burden on other north-south routes.

Once the project has been completed, a Letter of Map Revision (LOMR) request should be submitted that will, in part, revise the following flood hazards along Johnson Creek.

- The floodway will be revised from approximately 3,400 feet upstream of the confluence with the Rock River to approximately 1,100 feet downstream of Union Street along Johnson Creek. The floodway will increase and decrease within the revised area.
- 2. Base Flood Elevations (BFEs) will increase and decrease along Johnson Creek.
- The SFHA will increase and decrease along Johnson Creek.
